SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

Scholarships are **valid for the duration of study** as long as the student is in good academic standing. Scholarships (except for the President Merit Scholarship) and financial aid **may be combined up to 80% of tuition.**

President Merit Scholarship

100% for a select number of new undergraduates with excellent academic records

Early Admission Merit Scholarship

30% for students who apply and are admitted early

Legacy Scholarship

10% for students whose parents or grandparents are AUB graduates

Inaugural Cohorts Scholarship

20% for students enrolling in fall 2025 or fall 2026

AUB in Europe Scholarship

10% for students residing in and graduating from high schools or universities in the EU, EEA, or Switzerland; additional 10% for students who are also EU, EEA, or Swiss nationals

Financial Aid

Up to 70% of tuition based on financial need. A financial aid application must be submitted along with the admission application.

EARLY ADMISSION

Deadline: October 31, 2025 for fall 2026

Students with the **Cypriot Public Apolytirion** can apply until **July 31**. Apply by July 31, 2025 for fall 2025!

STUDENTS WHO MEET THE EARLY ADMISSION CRITERIA ARE GUARANTEED ADMISSION WITH A 30% EARLY ADMISSION MERIT SCHOLARSHIP!

Criteria: Rank in top 25% in both grades 10 and 11.

Achieve at least the minimum score on one of the following exams:

SAT/ACT exam: Can be taken several times. We take the highest score earned for each section (super-scoring).

Cypriot Public Apolytirion requires an additional math exam at AUB Mediterraneo.

Other exams: same subjects as those listed above for early admission.

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS



PHILOSOPHY, POLITICS, AND ECONOMICS (PPE) - BA

4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

A multidisciplinary program looking at the social, economic, and political issues and challenges facing the eastern Mediterranean in particular.

Includes a 4th year research project.



BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION IN MANAGEMENT - BBA

4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

Provides a solid foundation in all business disciplines and is aligned with the advancements and trends in the corporate world including data analytics, innovation, and entrepreneurship.



COMPUTER SCIENCE - BS

4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

Provides a theoretical and practical foundation so students can design, build, and deploy sophisticated systems using state-of-the-art technologies.



PSYCHOLOGY - BS

4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

Students explore psychological processes and functioning, gain knowledge and skills necessary for research and learn about the applications of psychology in the wider community.

Includes a 4th year thesis research project.



INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING - BS

4-year program (with 1 summer) 244 ECTS credits

Students learn to participate in, coordinate, and manage diverse teams. Courses include basic science, general education, business, and engineering fundamentals.

Includes a 3rd year summer internship.



We also offer a pre-med track for students interested in preparing for MD programs that follow the American model for medical education.
